



Presenter Guidelines

- 1. Your topic teaches something of social value. Our theme for the summer Ignite! Gunnison Valley events is “Build a Better World.” Try and keep that theme in mind.**
- 2. No sales pitches allowed.**
- 3. Talks are strictly five minutes long with automated slides. 20 slides, 15 seconds per slide.**
- 4. Your topic is above the belt.**
- 5. You have shown that you are prepared for your presentation. You have not blown off deadlines or emails.**
- 6. Your presentation does not include audio or video. Only static slides are allowed.**
- 7. The organizers vote on who gets accepted to present. We reserve the right to reject your submission.**

1. Your topic teaches something of **social value**.
2. Your topic is above the belt.
3. You have shown that you are prepared for your presentations (not missed the deadlines, blown off emails).
4. You have not told any of the organizers to fuck off, recently.
5. Your topic is an original presentation (you can't repeat something you have done before).
6. You must be indifferent but strangely committed to lists.
7. Your presentation does not include video or audio. Only static slides are allowed. No .gif's especially if you say 'jif' as if.
8. You do not pitch/promote your business. You must teach, not preach. (Our audience hates that kind of stuff, so it's not allowed.)
